Guidelines for Students

1. If you are late and cannot join your class, you must return to the school immediately and report to the school office. Otherwise you will be considered as playing truant.
2. You must wear school uniform on that day unless specified otherwise by the teacher in charge.
3. You must bring your HKID Card with you.
4. When you arrive at the destination, you must listen carefully to the announcements and follow the teachers' instructions. You must not go beyond the designated areas and you must take note of the time for departure.
5. You must also be abided by all house rules laid down by the keeper of the place of visit.
6. If you or your friends have an accident, you must keep calm and inform your teachers as quickly as possible.
7. You must keep the area clean.
8. You must take good care of your personal safety and do nothing to endanger the safety of other people.
9. You must take good care of your own property and avoid bring along valuables, the school bears no responsibility of any loss.
10. Before leaving home, you must pay attention to the weather report. If typhoon signal No.1 is hoisted or the amber rainstorm signal is hoisted, the outing will be cancelled. Students must return to school and bring the books for lessons on Monday.
11. If typhoon signal No.8 is hoisted or there is the red or black rainstorm warning signal, all school activities, including the outing will be cancelled. Students do not need to return to school on that day. They should stay at home.
